**ORDER TO SUMMONS JURORS FOR THE PERIOD FROM  
JANUARY 10, 2022 THROUGH JANUARY 14, 2022 FOR CIVIL CASES ONLY**


**WHEREAS**, the annual circuit calendar set criminal jury trials for the two-week period from January 3, 2022 to January 14, 2022, with civil cases as back-up; and

**WHEREAS**, by separate order the Court has cancelled criminal trials for the week of January 3, 2022 through January 7, 2022; it is

**ORDERED**, that all criminal jury trials for the period January 3, 2022 through January 14, 2022 are continued to the April session of jury trials. It is further

**ORDERED**, that the Clerk shall summons 200 jurors for civil cases only for the week of January 10, 2022 through January 14, 2022 and that 45 of said jurors be instructed to arrive in groups of 15 at staggered arrival times scheduled at 9:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. and the others placed on 2-hour call throughout the week.
